Before starting

- so that you can explore the lesson yourself in advance, to experience what your students will be asked to do. You can do this by clicking on 'Start demo' on your teachers' dashboard.
- Watch the of the young people in Stories that Move speaking on the themes of identity, discrimination, media and taking action.
- Each lesson consists of a number of steps with different assignments that students can scroll through.
- Make sure learners know that their answers will be shared (anonymously) within the group.
- Tell students that the lesson contains individual, pair, group and class assignments. You will indicate which assignments require them to wait when they've finished until the whole group is ready.
- Give a time limit for each step, taking into account your students' attainment levels. In the educators' guide for each lesson you will find a recommended time indication for each step.
- Research assignments and preparing presentations can be given as homework, individually or in small groups.

Working method

- **Tag clouds and graphs:** There are two ways of collecting individual student responses – by tag cloud or graph. A cloud shows the collected responses of all students, which you can discuss. A graph shows students' responses statistically, offering insight into different opinions.
- **Glossary:** Words highlighted in the online toolbox are explained in the glossary. Consider which words you want to discuss with the whole group to make sure they have been understood.
- **Information and instruction (i):** In the online toolbox, students can find additional information and instructions for some assignments under the 'i' tab.
- **Subtitles:** When watching a video together, check that the subtitles are on. The videos in the online tool are available subtitled in nine languages.
